- Approval of Minutes May 2021 Monthly Meeting
 - Minutes approved as written.
- 2021 MWBPP Annual Meeting (TBD) John Hooks -
 - Quick update on all four 2021 Annual Meetings.
 - Annual meeting breakout and panel session topic areas
 - Draft Agenda
 - John Hooks provided an update on discussions around the upcoming regional meetings.
 - NE may host a virtual meeting, however restrictions on meetings in Pennsylvania have been lifted.
 - SE is scheduled for Hot Springs.
 - The MW and W have decided to begin planning a joint meeting in Phoenix, AZ.
 - MW planning call is June 16th.
 - A combined planning (MW & W) call is slated for July.
 - One key value from Brad Noll was the opportunity to reengage with Bridge Practitioners since there have been a number of changes since last time we met in person.

MWBPP Bridge Inspection Program Manager Working Group – Nancy Huether & John Hooks

- Nancy provided a summary of the feedback related to this working group. Feedback from state reps have been very positive.
- Meeting set for June 8th.
- John provided an overview of how meetings are held in the SEBPP Bridge Inspection
 Program Manager Working Group meetings. It is very collaborative and often times

- consumes an entire hour of discussion on a particular topic. FHWA is a very involved partner in these calls.
- A document was created by the SE working group and Bill Oliva has requested that the document be shared with MW participants prior to future calls.
- It was noted that the parent committee of TSP2 is Committee on Maintenance, therefore
 the focus should remain on Maintenance related topics as it relates to Program Managers.
- Dave Juntunen, Kercher Group mentioned Minnesota DOT is sponsoring a peer review
 of coordination related to routine maintenance and capital improvement projects. Dave
 will be sending a questionnaire on behalf of MNDOT to Bridge Maintenance Engineers
 soliciting each states feedback.

• MWBPP Deterioration Modeling Working Group (Bill Oliva)

- Draft results from Task 6 Analysis (6.1 & 7.1)
- Draft is in the hands of DOT TAC members and Bill Oliva is currently coordinating a
 TAC only meeting to discuss any comments on the draft.
- Final deliverables include a final report, deterioration models related to NBI and NBE data, and Models that may be updated in the future by DOT's.

• National Bridge Deck Preservation WG (Pat Martens)

- Formation of a "Rigid Cementitious Concrete Overlay Sub-Working Group" that has been established to develop a pocket guide. We are also recruiting members for the subteam and we are sending out a very short survey for all the states to complete.

- Resource guide is being reviewed this month, and a final document is slated for next month.
- Each partnership has provided support for additional research on RCCO, and the Steering Committee has matched that support. Therefore, \$20,000 has been allocated for this project in total.

• Railroad Permissible windows (Paul Pilarski)

The MWBPP be a forum for sharing experiences and generating examples of projects where delivery costs and impacts are being significantly affected by the RR partnering. MnDOT is trying to program a paint project for a steel bridge over the BNSF line and multiple meetings in with the railroad has resulted in only 1-hour closure windows. As you know, this makes it near impossible to do work. It is unreasonable and I suspect many other agencies are finding similar tough negotiations.

 Ashley Gryzbowski and Nate Schutte shared a presentation giving an overview of the rail system and the owner/operators legislation/regulations related to bridge work. In summary DOT's do not have much influence on rail owner/operators to comply with construction related activities. Field Code Changed
