5. Round Table Discussion

Under deck delamination removal and/or repair

Paul Pilarski - Capture deck patching quantities and tie to chloride testing – looking at research.

Michigan DOT (Brandon Boatman and Todd Strockee) presented AASHTO Committee on Maintenance – talked about catch platforms. MDOT has different techniques for an issue with underdeck failures over traffic. Tested different options for catching the debris but issues with inspection depending on the system used. Jason DeRuyver (MDOT) provided an update. Catch system just sits on the beam bottom.

Paul Pilarski (MnDOT) is using clear catch system on an old bridge over a park area.

Historically, practice has been to chip the cover concrete and do not repair, in general.

Iowa and Wisconsin just chip off the loose concrete and do not patch. Exposed rebar seems to allow area to dry out faster.
