## **ROLL CALL**

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#### PREVIOUS TELECONFERENCE MINUTES

• Motion for August meeting minutes approved.

#### **RESEARCH**

• There are 41 university transportation centers (UTC) established under the Fast Act with funding through FY23. There are 6 theme or subject areas covered by these centers. Two of these themes, improving durability and extending life of transportation infrastructure and preserving the existing transportation system, appear appropriate to house research on bridge

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preservation. Tripp had students do a scan of research work the UTC are performing and found there are 215 completed/on-going projects. Tripp scanned through these projects and found 15 bridge preservation related projects based on a first scan. Tripp has compiled spreadsheet and will send it out to the partnership.

• There was discussion of approaching UTC to partner in completing partnership priority research projects. Dick offered to approach Rutgers, which is a UTC.
