3. COVID Vaccination Requirements

- Maine
 - Not Implemented yet however significant concerns about impacts particularly about maintenance in the southern portion
 - Specific concerns about plowing. Union rule puts 15-hour limit with 8 hours off however with less people it will be more difficult.
 - Some camps have had COVID and had to shut down completely
 - Changed some things to one person per vehicle to reduce spread of COVID to everyone, cannot repair one bridge due to this policy
- Massachusetts
 - In effect vaccination requirement
 - Lost about 7% of staff including key staff
- Connecticut
 - Show proof of vaccination or weekly testing
 - September beyond hires need to be vaccinated
 - o Issues returning to work because of quarantine can't get tested because unavailable.
 - Staff availability is the greatest concern
- Delaware
 - Similar to ConnDOT
 - Week wait for testing but most have complied
 - Lots of missing staff however they are managing again snow plowing is the biggest issue
 - Telecommuting for January
- Maryland
 - Requirement for all state employees to wear masks in public spaces in office buildings
 - No vaccination requirements
 - o Contactor issues with getting people (outsource maintenance activities to contractors)
 - o More funding issues than anything needed to scale back state spending and more federal aid
 - Teleworking across the state
- New York State
 - Vaccinate or test
 - o Employee health services contractor mails test instead of going to test sites

- o Hard time recruiting staff down 10% of staff not directly to COVID, payscale issue
- Pennsylvania
 - o No vaccination requirements
 - o Masking required
- New Hampshire
 - o Not an OSHA state so no requirement
 - o Treating vaccinated employees differently particularly with the close contacts
 - o Providing N95 masks, about half people wear masks
 - O Down 20% vacancies
 - Volunteer plow list, likely going towards requiring anyone with CDL to plow
