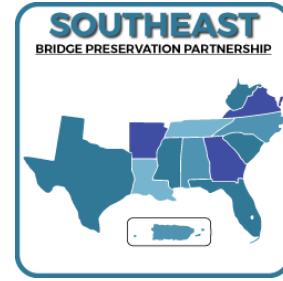


Southeast Bridge Preservation Partnership
